



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WordPress SEO by Yoast is one for the most popular WordPress plugins of all time, and also one of the most popular SEO plugins available.


With your plugin you have the ability to optimize much of the on-site content easily and efficiently. The bulk of the features in the plugin are 100% free with a few extensions available for additional features.

WordPress SEO by Yoast can be manually controlled on every page and post you create. Or you can generate a template system so that each of your new pages and posts automatically receive appropriate metadata for SEO.

Combine all of that with the built-in analyzer, you can see how well your content will hold up when optimized for a specific keyword.

An alternative and popular SEO plugin is All-In-One-SEO.

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
MonsterInsights (formally Google Analytics by Yoast) is also one of the most popular WordPress plugins of all time.

There are many Google Analytics plugins available for WordPress. But we have found that the MonsterInsights plugin has taken the steps to simplify the process of adding the Analytics scripts to website, and in the correct ways, and with added benefits.

First and foremost, the plugin allows you to connect either a basic Google Analytics script or the newer Universal Analytics script. Additionally, you have the option of secluding specific roles, like Admin or Editor, so that anyone logged in is not tracked in your Analytics.

The plugin offers even more features which are worth looking at.

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Contact Form 7 might be one of those plugins you didn't realize you needed. Many times we see creatives place their plain email address on their contact pages. While we agree having it can be important for a business. Sometimes it's easier and better for spam prevention to use a contact form. Or using a contact form can direct specific emails to specific departments. Kind of like what you see on the Imagely contact page.

Contact Form 7 is the most popular, free, contact form plugin. It does a heck of a lot for such a niche plugin, and it's built up the reputation to match its popularity.

On the next page we're going to discuss another contact form plugin and why it could be a better option, although it's not free.

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
Gravity Forms is the leader in premium contact forms. It is packed with many amazing features that literally allow you to use contact forms for many different purposes.

For example, hypothetically if a client books your services then instead of sending an email with a document to gather important information related to the job you can use Gravity Forms. With the plugin you have the ability to set up surveys, questionnaires, quizzes and so much more. There is even an extension to allow signatures which can be done using a computer's trackpad or a mobile device.

As mentioned, the plugin is not free. It starts at \$39 a year with no access to add-ons and makes its way up to \$199 a year depending on your needs.

But if you see yourself wanting to do more with contact forms then Gravity Forms is the ideal choice.

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


Spam has always been a problem with WordPress websites, unfortunately. Really spam is a problem everywhere. Automattic has a plugin called Akismet which requires an account, and potentially paying for, to prevent spam. Even with Akismet we've found spam getting through. Until we tried WordPress Zero Spam. Since then we've literally had no spam break through.


The way the plugin works is by tracking IP addresses across the Internet. It knows common spam IPs and will block any actions on your site from those IPs. It will also track the IP usage across your website preventing registration, commenting and even form completions from Contact Form 7 and Gravity Forms.

WordPress Zero Spam is a free plugin available to everyone. We strongly recommend trying it out on your website.

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
The next three plugins we decided to include on one page because they all do similar things, but in different ways. Also, not all hosting providers can handle them all.

Imsanity takes a different approach by shrinking images, not necessarily with further compression, so that uploaded images are never a large size. The size limit is set by the site admin.

EWWW Image Optimizer is forbidden on many WordPress Managed Hosting platforms. However, the plugin also comes in a cloud based version which requires a subscription for cloud server optimized images distributed back to your website.

The advantage to optimizing images is faster loading times, better SEO and an overall better user experience.

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
Many photographers are now using <u>BufferApp.com</u> as a means to schedule social media postings. Buffer allows you to strategically schedule posts to Facebook (profiles, pages and groups), LinkedIn (profiles, pages and groups), Twitter and Google Plus pages.

With WordPress to Buffer (free) you have the ability to add new posts to your Buffer queue. With the Pro (paid) version of the plugin you have advanced options like the ability to add posts more than once, or to use Custom Post Types.

With Buffer My Posts you have the ability to schedule your website to automatically add older posts to your Buffer queue at a set schedule. For example, add 1 old post to Buffer every 48 hours.

Using Buffer and automating some of your social media activity can lead to more time running your business or doing the creative stuff.

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


When it comes to writing and scheduling articles it is often easier to stay organized with a calendar, which is more comfortable and used throughout our daily lives.

Editorial Calendar is a plugin whose only purpose is to provide a calendar to drag and drop scheduled and drafted posts. The plugin makes organizing your content schedule extremely simple.

CoSchedule is a premium service which offers a calendar as well as social sharing to a variety of channels. It also integrates with Buffer for additional scheduling opportunities and syncs with Google Calendar so you can stay up to date on your schedule from anywhere.

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NextGEN Gallery has been the most popular WordPress gallery plugin for many years. It has the ability to organize your galleries in a portfolio style system. Each gallery is segregated but can be combined into an album for further organization.


It provides a powerful engine for uploading and managing galleries of images, with the ability to batch upload, import meta data, add/delete/rearrange/sort images, edit thumbnails, group galleries into albums, and more.

It also provides two front-end display styles (slideshows and thumbnail galleries), both of which come with a wide array of options for controlling size, style, timing, transitions, controls, lightbox effects, and more.

NextGEN Gallery also offers watermarking, original image backups, resizing and multiple built-in lightboxes for enlarging thumbnails.

NextGEN Gallery is developed by Imagely, the team who put this document together for you.

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There are so many social sharing plugins out there, and so many styles. We picked out our two favorite which work with nearly all themes. We also picked two that load the fastest on your websites.

Monarch from Elegant Themes contains multiple sharing locations and options. Sharing can be floating, above and below post content, on top of images and more. The icons load from a font so site speed is not an issue. The plugin also includes stats which you can view within the Monarch settings.

Shareaholic is similar to Monarch except with less location options. However, the list of sharing channels is larger. It also relies on the Shareaholic server for much of the functionality and for stats, so without that your site won't have the sharing functionality.

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Keeping people on your website is tricky business. A proven method of increasing retention is to offer additional content related to what the viewer is looking at.


Shareaholic is the perfect plugin for the job. It allows you automatically add related content (with images) to the bottom of posts.

The best part about Shareaholic is that it will not slow your website down. The plugin utilizes Shareaholic's servers to analyze and deliver the related content. That means you get all the benefit without the server strain other plugins might cause.

Shareaholic also includes social sharing which is convenient (mentioned on the previous page)

An alternative would be to use <u>Jetpack</u> from Automattic, which also includes a related posts feature and uses on the Jetpack servers.

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


WordPress search is convenient, but has its limitations. With Relevanssi you can enhance the search results.

Relevanssi has the ability to customize the search results with more targeted and specific results.

It will look for keywords throughout posts and pages to determine what's the most relevant to the search query. Additionally, Relevanssi offers search tracking so you can stay up to date on what people are searching for, right within your WordPress dashboard.

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
Do you know when your website is down?

If not then be sure to check out WP Website Monitoring. Unlike the complex and expensive website monitoring systems out there, this one is completely free and all it takes is supplying your email address.

Yes, it's that simple. The developer's servers run all the time checking user's websites for downtime. Once it notices that your website is down it will send an email to you with an alert.

From there you can contact your website host to find out what is going on.

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OptinMonster Converts Visitors into Subscribers & Customers

Imagine having the power to turn your website visitors into subscribers and customers. OptinMonster enables you to create professionally designed optin forms without writing a single line of code in 60 seconds flat.


You are most liking trying to capture email addresses on your website. OptinMonster makes that process extremely painless and does it in a beautiful way.

OptinMonster has multiple plans, but even the least expensive plan still delivers with increased email capture.

The plugin comes with various display styles as well as split testing so you can see what works, what doesn't and adjust.

It syncs with the most popular email marketing software, like <u>AWeber</u> and <u>Mailchimp</u>.

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


If you are ever in a situation where you have written a blog post and need an outside view for feedback maybe you need approval for the article before you hit publish. Public Post Preview is a great plugin to help that process.

With it you can turn on a public preview URL so that anyone with the URL can see the post draft, even without an account on your WordPress website.

There are a few plugins available that do the same thing, but they all work the same and as well as each other. With no differences we decided to only share Public Post Preview.

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A few pages back we talked about NextGEN Gallery, the WordPress gallery plugin. To close out this document we wanted to talk about NextGEN Pro as well.

NextGEN Pro is a premium add-on to NextGEN Gallery, offering additional and more modern responsive display styles. It also includes one-on-one support with the Photocrati team.

NextGEN Pro is also an Ecommerce plugin which means you can sell your images easily through the plugin. The Ecommerce system accepts PayPal, Stripe and Check payments for self fulfilled prints and automated digital downloads.

Images can be protected from right click and drag and drop as well as watermarking which is included in NextGEN Gallery. NextGEN Pro also includes proofing options for creatives who need their customers to approve of images prior.
